



A fumble and recovery came when the pressures increased. Sacking came about smartly, too!



First to score! Last to score! Most to score! No score by them went unanswered by us...


The numbers aren't impressive, but the score was good of NFC South.

Our best gunner, a giant human being, had stolen from him five times on the last time the battle was at the Banks of Amerigo...


This time... Ahrr, THIS time, the big man gave nothing away!


There was some success in the middle-to-right side, but a good amount of those yards came when the quarterback ran. These paltry numbers need to improve, else the rations of grog will soon be halved!



A long punt with a short return netted forty-eight yards on the first salvo...


A penalty aided the second punt...

Then, a fake field goal was punted into the end zone...


A nice forty-eight yard punt from the three yard line gave the defense some breathing room...


The last punt was downed inside the ten yard line...



#### Kick Returns








There was no remarkable kick return. One punt return went for twentythree yards. Some punts were fairly caught...






