

2010 Pass Defense


Yar, mateys!

Here I be again... I've come about for another "Reckonings" from th' last season. I did th' run defense in th' last loggin'. Now, it's time to be lookin' at th' pass defense.....

Firstly, some of th' same things apply th' way they did for th' run defense. Some things are different for th' look at th' pass defense. Namely, "Tackles" and "Stops" were used to look at runs. While "Tackles" are th' same for pass plays, they ahrr not th' only way to stop a pass play. Add "Interceptions" and "Defenses" = to "Tackles", and call them "Plays". "Stops" differ for pass defense by using "Plays" instead of just "Tackles" = for th' cipherin'. Because they ahrr self-inflicted, "Incompletions" ahrr not to be merited as part of th' pass defense...

Secondly, also different from run defense, thar be two aspects to pass defense... "Coverage", th' main focus of this report, and "Pressure". Our krewe was highly ranked in th' league for coverage, but th' worst for pressure. Could one part have something to do with th' other part? More to be written later... on that regard...


